Confirmation is offered in the spring when the bishop visits St. Paul's, and the Inquirers Class, which is offered twice a year, serves as preparation for Confirmation. In the Episcopal Church, Confirmation is not required for full membership but is necessary for those who wish to serve as a chalice-bearer, a member of the Vestry, or in few other particular ministries.
