Discussed refinancing and the associate rector search committee budget. If needed, the budget for the search committee could be increased. The committee recommended approving the search committee budget. Budget unanimously approved by vestry vote.

Leslie has been covering Joy's duties. The committee is looking at recommendations to lessen the burden.

Stewardship of Creation discussed the glass recycling program and made a recommendation

to the finance committee to spend \$10 a month on glass pick up. The finance committee recommends and moves that we spend the money as recommended. The vestry unanimously approved the motion.

Need to move quickly to eliminate plastic usage within the parish. Internal policy has been updated to remove single-use items, and compostable items when single-use cannot be avoided.
